**Steps to a Successful Registration**

- ★ Please read everything *thoroughly*.
- ★ Please **note on-line registration deadline** and **postmark deadline** . . . and *meet them*.
- ★ Friendly suggestion - **request your PO prior-to submitting your on-line pre-registration**. When you receive your online Reservation/**INVOICE** Confirmation, your PO is in place and your check can be cut from the INVOICE! Your **PO Number is required on the online registration form**.
- ★ Please highlight the word **INVOICE** at the top of your Online Reservation/**INVOICE** Confirmation hard copy before you submit it to your school bookkeeper or district financial officer.
- ★ Please ensure that your payment is in the form of one school check; or a money order that you generate. (**NMASC does not accept purchase orders, credit cards, or cash - thank you.**)

  - Please USPS mail First Class or Priority Mail ONLY (**NO** (✉) signature required)

**Take note:**

- ★ **There is one registration deadline** for 2021:  
Online Registration closes **December 6, 2020** – midnight
- ★ Registration cost for 2021 Virtual Conference is **\$20.00/student delegate and advisor/adult attending**  
Registration Payment must be postmarked by **December 18, 2020**
- ★ NMASC is capping registration at a total of **20 students per school**
- ★ This includes your school's voting delegate and any district officers, if applicable; **NO Bonus Delegates**  
Registration Payment must be postmarked by December 18, 2020 - USPS in one envelope the following 4 items:
  - ★ **1) the hard copy of your on-line pre-registration form**
  - ★ **2) your payment**
  - ★ **3) Workshop Application (which will be available soon)**
  - ★ **4) School Permission Form**

**General Registration Information:**

- **Every school will present one (1) workshop - either - a Student-Led Workshop** (peer to peer) **or an Adult-Led Workshop** (advisor to students). *Specifics coming soon!*
- Each school **will register one student voting delegate**. (might be your Stu Co President, or your most responsible delegate! **May not be** a workshop presenter, **or** officer candidate, **or** district president)
- NMASC Virtual **State Contest Information** is available at [nmasc.org](https://nmasc.org) \* **Awards/Contests Tab** – scroll down:
  - February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 is the Submission deadline for each of the following 4 contests.
  - The following contests have two links: **Contest Guidelines and Judging Rubric** – **please open both Banner** – will be submitted as a **video**; **School Fun Fact** will be voiced in your Banner video.  
**Roll Call** – will be submitted on **Flipgrid**  
**Scrapbook** – will be submitted in **Google Slides**  
**Projects** – (limit 2 per school from the categories listed) will be submitted in **Prezi**
    - **Project of the Year** submission categories must be indicated on the online registration form.
  - Submission of each of these will be *very easy*, using the appropriate button found on [nmasc.org](https://nmasc.org)
  - There are **no video examples** of the contests available; please read and follow the guidelines and rubric for each contest.
- **Student Council of the Year – will be submitted hard copy as usual**
  - **January 17, 2021** USPS Mail postmark or drop-off deadline
  - There are many changes to Student Council of the Year.
  - Please read through the entire application.
  - Yes, your application will include a project for each Project Category (10 categories).
  - **HOWEVER** – **One project related to COVID may be substituted for one on the project category list for 2020**
  - if you did a project, that your council deems as COVID Related, it does not matter from which Project Category, you may use that **one** project to substitute a project category that your school was not able to fulfill this year. **Please indicate COVID Related** on the project category line of the substitute project.

→ **Student Names are not required until January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2021.** But are *required not later than* January 20<sup>th</sup>!

→ **Registration includes:** Keynote speaker fees; conference swag box sent to each school with goodies for each of your registered delegates; miscellaneous conference costs.

→ **January 17, 2021 Student Council of the Year Award/Binder – USPS Deadline**

Participating Student Councils must have paid 2021 state conference registration, and must be in attendance at the 2021 state conference to receive their earned accolade.

- Gold Student Council of the Year is designed to recognize Student Councils operating at a top tier!
- Each student in your council is not required to participate in every project.
- Create committees in your council who are responsible to plan, execute and write up their project.
- There are many changes that were made to the 2020 SCOY Application before COVID. NMASC's job is to promote the best and most fair recognition, reflective of the hard work and dedication of our student leaders across the state. Leadership is being able to adjust to current circumstances!

→ **February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 NMAA Eligibility Form **AND** list of state conference student delegates - is due directly to NMAA - ATTN: Dana Pappas**
