Summer Workshop Packing Checklist

- Bed linens: sheets, pillow, blanket (or a sleeping bag)
- Towels and washcloth, shower shoes
- Appropriate "camp attire" which is representative of any student council position. Please
 refrain from bringing controversial clothing. Casual attire appropriate for school wear is
 suitable within the guidelines of the general NMASC rules.
 - jeans, capris, sports attire, comfortable shoes, athletic shoes, and a sweatshirt or light jacket
- Dress-up summer attire is required for the sit-down dinner/banquet.
 - banquet clothes: sports coat or dress shirt and tie, dress socks; a nice party dress and appropriate shoes (this is a *nice dress*, <u>not</u> formal, event) Remember the Rule of 4 B's and a C (no bra straps, bellies, boxers, butts or cleavage showing! Keep it classy! Dress to impress- don't dress less!
 - wear your school t-shirt on Tuesday
 - Wednesday, Thursday and Friday you will wear Summer Workshop t-shirts
 - Appropriate swim attire: Swim trunks (not shorts, not boxers --- swim trunks); a one piece swim suit or a tankini; modest 2-piece: please bring a t-shirt or cover-up (although the pool rules do not allow you to wear a t-shirt in the pool) are the appropriate attire for the pool party events.
- Bathrobe
- Hangers, alarm clock
- Personal grooming and toiletries: shower soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.
- Sunscreen, sunglasses and hat or visor for outdoor activities
- Extra towel, or beach towel for the pool mixer
- Money for vending machines (card or dollar bills and quarters), snacks, etc.
- A bookbag or backpack is helpful
- School supplies: notebook, pencils, pens
- Medications: any prescription or over-the-counter medicine you may need for four days
- Optional: umbrella, camera, musical instrument
- If you are performing Individual Talent in the Summer Workshop Talent Show, bring your music, instrument, costume, etc.
- At the time of the NMASC Activity, Executive Orders will be followed. Unless stated otherwise, wearing a facemask is an individual choice.
